## RESOLUTION NO. 2022-20

### Amending the FY 2020-2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

**WHEREAS**, the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is the organization designated by the Governor of the State of Alabama as being responsible, together with the State of Alabama, for implementing the applicable provisions of 23 USC 134 and 135 (amended by the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act, Section 11201, November 2021); 42 USC 2000d-1, 7401; 23 CFR 450 and 500; 40 CFR 51 and 93; and

**WHEREAS**, Title 23 USC and 23 CFR 450.324 require that transportation projects in urbanized areas, funded by the Federal Highway Administration and the Federal Transit Administration, be included in a Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), amended as often as required, and adopted by the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO); and

**WHEREAS**, consistent with the declaration of these provisions, the Eastern Shore MPO, in cooperation with the Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT), adopted the Fiscal Year (FY) 2020-2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) on September 25, 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, the Eastern Shore MPO recognizes the need for additional capacity on I-10 across Mobile Bay; and

**WHEREAS**, The I-10 Mobile River Bridge and Bayway project is a proposal to increase the capacity of I-10 by constructing a new six-lane bridge, across the Mobile River, and increase the capacity across Mobile Bay from four lanes to six lanes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Eastern Shore MPO desires to include the following project in the FY 2020-2023 TIP:

**Project 2: Bayway (ESMPO) – I-10 Bayway from Mobile County Line to East of the Eastern Shore Interchange (Exit 35) SR-16 (US-90)**

**PE:** 100073595  
State = \$0  
Federal (INFRA) = \$45,000,000  
**Total = \$45,000,000**

**CN:** 100073597  
State = \$125,000,000  
Federal = \$475,510,000  
Other = \$288,950,000  
**Total = \$889,460,000**

**WHEREAS**, the Eastern Shore MPO believes the amendment listed above will support the performance targets established by the State of Alabama and supported by the Eastern Shore MPO; now

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Eastern Shore Metropolitan Planning Organization, having reviewed the foregoing, does hereby amend the FY 2020-2023 Transportation Improvement Program as summarized above.
